



**HANG-A-STORY** is a device for helping readers keep track of an emerging story

At the end of each day's coverage of a novel, a student volunteers a one sentence summary of events

Students can then generate a prediction of the upcoming installment (the prediction is written in red).

At the next reading, the summary statement(s) and the prediction are read. After the next coverage of the text, a new summary is formulated, the prediction is examined and a new prediction is generated.

Students who are absent can catch up by reading the HANG-A STORY.

Students can also construct their own HANG-A-STORY from self-selected readings and share with the class.

The HANG-A-STORY can be used to reinforce sequence and to help write story summaries.
